ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING AND MANAGEMENT CAPACITY **BUILDING IN THE KYRGYZ REPUBLIC**

Well-defined information on environment is required in order to make sound judgements about priorities in environmental protection. Reliable and adequate information will help to ensure that the most urgent environmental issues are tackled first in the current harsh financial situation in the country.



The objective of the project is to assist local authorities in gathering information on the state of the environment for decision-making, and, subsequently, to improve the state of the environment in the country. The purpose is to strengthen the capacity of national institutions to effectively perform environmental monitoring and data management in the country.

Activities

- Implementation of a training-of-trainers programme for environmental monitoring and data management.
- · Carrying out pilot scale monitoring, data management and permitting activities under training case studies.
- · Provision of two mobile monitoring units and data management equipment for the training
- Drafting plans for environmental monitoring and data management.
- · Preparation of guidelines and manuals
