

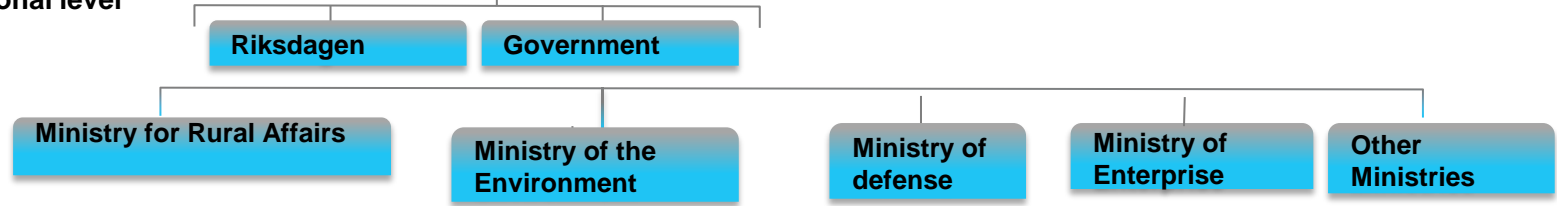

Bilateral meeting with COM

Actions

- Explanations required on what is needed to ensure that the risk-based WFD principles on monitoring are fully implemented given the approach to mainly use existing monitoring systems
- Sweden to make a critical review of their legislation in relation to permitting of new hydromorphological modifications.
- Give further written clarification on the completion of their assessment methods for all required biological quality elements
- Explain how it will ensure that GW monitoring for the 2nd cycle will to a large extent follow a risk-based approach to capture the important pressures, is comprehensive and follows a WFD compliant strategy.



Bilateral meeting with COM

Actions

- SE to clarify how financing adds up to meet the challenges of PoM
- Provide clear commitment in the 2nd RBMPs for properly prioritised measures and the review of hydropower permits.
- Ensure better justification and application of exemptions in the 2nd cycle, including linking water and nature legislation.
- Provide further information on how the permitting process is used to consider costs for environmental damages.
- Report to COM on how it will ensure that Article 4(7) is fully implemented.
- Definition of water services not discussed due to ongoing court case.
