## Egyptian Antiquities Information System (EAIS)

Egypt has one of the most outstanding geographic resource bases of historic sites and monuments in the world. These sites provide an essential element for the development of the country.



The overall objective of the project is the preservation of the Egyptian cultural heritage through improved Cultural Heritage Management. The purpose of the project is to provide the Supreme Council of Antiquities (SCA) with new data management tools and resources, and thereby improve its ability to perform its mandatory tasks of mapping, documentation and protection of archaeological sites in Egypt.

## **Activities**

- The design of a GIS application and related archaeological database for data management of all historically valuable sites of Egypt.
- Baseline studies on data on historic sites (geographical, archaeological, decrees etc.).
- Development of data handling processes and related quality control.
- Institutional development and definition of necessary short term actions.
- Collaboration with governmental offices and other end users of the information system.
- Development and testing of methods and products to disseminate data.
