

PEF information: Possibilities for Type I eco-labels

I. USE READILY AVAILABLE PEF INFORMATION

II. CREATE PEF INFORMATION

PEFCRs and other readily available related material are used in defining which criteria to set.

PEF studies are carried out in setting criteria and given as an option to licenseapplicants to get points

III. REQUIRE PEF INFORMATION

Criteria are PEF-based and a PEF study is required from companies.



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
